Social Action – update

Care Homes Judith Dufour, our lay pastoral chaplain has prepared bags, each containing a holding cross and a pray for each resident whom we normally visit in our care homes. Selina is distributing them to the 9 care homes.

Schools Helena Power, our schools' and families' chaplain in Rockwell Green and St John's schools has prepared a report on all that she has been doing over the last term. Her activities include being around on the playground and at the school gates to get to know children, staff & parents, developing a prayer group WhatsApp group for support, delivering Godly play sessions, working with the pupil chaplains in St John's, providing a 'sanctuary' prayer and reflection space for children at St John's, working with the Wellington Community One Team, especially over food vouchers.
